#### **4-H Livestock Auction Checks**

Last year, we piloted check pickup at the office versus having the multiple steps. Checks will once again be bulk issued and at the 4-H Office.

The process will be:

- I. Youth must complete a thank you to the buyer(s).
- 2. Youth must show completed thank you at the office.
- If the buyer has paid their invoice, we will release checks once we receive confirmation from Great Western Bank.

The checks will not be mailed and will need to be picked up by the youth.

# Families: South Dakota State Fair Preparation

Many families will be preparing to attend the South Dakota State Fair in a couple weeks. As you begin to prepare for the 4-H division, our county office will guide you in making your experience stress-free.

#### **STATIC EXHIBITS**

All static exhibits registered for State Fair must be brought to the 4-H Office by Tuesday, August 27, 11:00 a.m.

**NOTE:** For transportation reasons, the project must fit in a tote. Any large projects will be the families responsibility to find a way to get them to and from judging. Families are welcome to pack projects in their

own tote.

Sara will bring all static exhibits to State Fair for judging. Please make sure all exhibits have the display exhibit form or special exhibit form attached. Each exhibit going will have a new entry card attached by the 4-H Office.

For Horticulture, youth exhibiting any horticulture lots, may enter another specimen in that class or another vegetable class at the South Dakota State Fair. Youth must complete a new exhibit entry form when substituting another vegetable and staple it to the original exhibit entry form that show the county ribbon placing.

(Please refer to the South Dakota 4-H Fairbook for more information.)

Exhibits will be returned to the 4-H Office on Tuesday, September 3. Pickup will be available from September 4-6. Any exhibits not picked up by September 27 will be discarded.

#### **ANIMAL EXHIBITORS**

All animal exhibitors (except cat) will need a show number that will be provided by our 4-H Office. Numbers will be mailed week of August 19.

## **End of 4-H Year Information**

As Achievement Days are over and SD State Fair is approaching, I want to encourage youth to start thinking about working on your 4-H Record and end of the year information. All information will be posted to our BOX folder starting August 12.

The 4-H record book is a summary of the member's entire year. While a 4-Her may receive recognition during the year for participating in activities or with an exhibit at the fair, record books measures the growth and accomplishments the 4-Her has made through the entire year. There have been a few youth that have mentioned completing a record book has assisted in completing scholarships and developing a resume.

This process is not meant to be a headache. Therefore, I will be holding two 4-H record book work days during September.

Wednesday, August 14 at 2-5 PM

Tuesday, September 10 at 2-5 PM

Besides the 4-H Record Book, youth are to complete two other requirements for the 4-H year.

- Must attend four club meetings.
- 2. Must give a public presentation/demonstration at club or higher level.

These requirements are not to be stressful but are easy for families to complete. Therefore, with completion, youth will receive awards and monies during our annual Recognition Event in November.

A big part of our 4-H Recognition Event is recognizing our youth who apply for top awards and scholarships.

## SD 4-H Leaders provide Camp Fee Assistance

The SD 4-H Leaders will once again provide financial assistance scholarship to 4-H members attending a 4-H camp, Performing Arts, TLC or SDSU Youth Livestock Judging Camp.

The scholarship amount for 4-H
Camp (Poinsett & Bob Marshall) is
\$25. The requirement for receiving
the scholarship is that the camper
needs to tell one group about camp.
The application is due by December
31st.

The scholarship amount for Performing Arts or TLC or Livestock

Judging Assistance is \$50. The requirement for receiving the scholarship is that the 4-H'er needs to tell two groups about camp. The application is due by December 31st.

# Here is how the scholarship program works.

Step I – Register for the 2019 camp and pay the full camp fees.
Step 2 – Attend camp and have a

great time!!

Step 3 – Tell a group about camp.

For the \$25 4-H Camp scholarship, tell one group. For the \$50 TLC or Performing Arts Camp or Livestock Judging Camp scholarship tell two

groups.

Step 4 - Complete the camp assistance/scholarship application form with all signatures and submit to the SD 4-H Leaders. You will receive your scholarship money within 2 weeks of its receipt.
