No Encroachment in County Right of Ways

NOTICE OF RIGHT-OF-WAY LAWS

For reasons of liability, it is necessary for Grant County to enforce the state laws that protect the county right-of-ways. Anyone who compromises the roadway or its right-of-way can be charged.

Examples are, but not limited to: planting in right-of-way, irrigation water going onto roads, dumping trash in ditches and pushing snow into ditches. The charge depends on the severity of the offense and the intention of the offender. Any crops planted in the road right-of-way of county maintained roads will be removed by the Grant County Highway Department.

Permits are required for the following activities within the road right of way:

- Adding an approach
- Utility installation
- Overweight or oversized vehicles
- Drainage
