UTILITY PERMIT – Grant County

1. Construction, operation, maintenance, reconstruction, or removal of said facilities within the county right-of-way shall be completed in a manner satisfactory to, and subject to supervision by, the County Road Superintendent and/or County Commissioners.
2. Installations of pipe under concrete or bituminous pavements to be done by jacking or boring.
3. When trenching across surfaced roads material excavated must be piled separately.
4. All back-fill must be performed in an approved manner and be placed in 6" layers and thoroughly tamped and material must be flush and even with the road surface when finally in place.
5. Concrete pavement to be replaced according to State specifications.
6. If settlement occurs or excavation caves in so that replaced materials settle (bituminous mat or concrete base) same shall be restored to its original condition.
7. No pole anchors, braces or other construction to be put on roadway shoulder or slope.
8. No driving onto highway from ditch or driving on shoulders where damage will occur.
9. When an installation is made by jacking or boring, a pipe or casing of larger dimension must be used to encase the service pipe.

LIMITATIONS

1. No lugs shall be used on equipment traversing road which will damage the road surface.
2. Roadside should be cleaned up after work is completed.
3. If County Highway Department shall make any improvements or change on all or any part of its R/W upon, over, under or along the county highway then and in every case the applicant herein named shall, after notice from the County Highway Superintendent or his authorized agents proceed to alter, change, vacate or remove from County Highway R/W said works necessary to conform with said changes without cost whatsoever to the County.
4. If drains are installed they must be of sufficient size in order that overflow and damage to property will not occur.
5. No work shall be done which will create a nuisance.
6. After work on a project is completed said persons doing such work must notify the County Highway Superintendent that such work has been completed and ready for final inspection and acceptance by the County.
7. Upon completion of construction, operation, maintenance, relocation, or removal of said facilities, Applicant and or their assignee, is responsible for restoration of any and all damages to County right-of-way as directed by the County Commissioners, or pay for restoration to be completed by the County or their designated representative.
8. The Applicant and or their assignee shall hold Grant County harmless for injury to persons or damage to property resulting from the activities conducted by the Applicant in crossing any existing road or section line.

NOTE: A certified check may be required to insure proper restoration of highway surfaces and to cover payment for any damage to highways or county property.
